We invite you to take part in the **International Course of Musical Interpretation in Nowy Sącz**, a city created in the Middle Ages, the city with a rich history, many outstanding monuments, original folklore and talented, ambitious and enterprising people.

Lying in the Kotlina Sądecka, in the forks of the Dunajec and Kamienica, rivers having their sources in the mountains – Nowy Sącz – is a friendly and warm city, It is surrounded by mountains – from the south by the Beskid Sądecki with Radziejowa and Jaworzyna Krynicka, from the east by the Beskid Niski, from the west by the Beskid Wyspowy, and on the north by the Pogórze Rożnowskie, further by Gorce, Pieniny and the Tatra Mountains.

It is here since 1996 that young musicians can develop their skills, musicality and virtuosity under the guidance of outstanding artists from Poland and the world.

The initiator of the course was **Prof. Barbara Halska** – chamber musician, pianist from the Fryderyk Chopin University of Music in Warsaw, artistic director from the first edition of the course.

The assumption of this project was: chamber music at the highest possible level, master classes, the possibility of presenting at the stage a piece mastered during the course – a student's performance with the master. This idea works to this day. The scale of course development is illustrated by the number of participants – in 1996 there were 25 participants, while in recent years, the course gathers over 300 people.

We organize open-air and traditional concerts, chamber, symphonic and solo concerts in the places of our region located on historical "Hungarian" and "amber" trade routes.

The challenge for the contemporary artist is the ability to perform in different acoustic conditions. We have friends in many places, that's why we organize concerts of participants and professors in various rooms, in interesting places, attractive in terms of tourism and landscape.
